FAQs

What is SCL?

SCL stands for “Students City Limits”. SCL is our Students Fall Retreat. Normally, SCL is a three-day, two-night event. It’s no surprise things look different this year, so instead of our normal overnight event, we are taking all of the fun of SCL and packing it into one full day out at T Bar M Camps & Retreats! When registering, you will have the choice to drive your student or reserve a spot on a bus ride to and from the camp. These buses will be capped at 50% capacity. The day will include worship, teaching, breakouts, two meals, snacks, freetime, and a great time with friends and leaders. All activities, worship sessions, and meals are planned to be held outdoors.

Who can participate?

Any student that is currently in 6th through 12th grade! Our students are encouraged to invite any guests and friends too!

Who will be their leader?

Your students will be hanging out with their DCOMM and their DCOMM Leaders. All of our leaders who will be participating in SCL will have completed applications, interviews, background checks, child abuse prevention trainings, and other Austin Stone policy and procedure trainings.

Health and Safety

- Students will go through a health screening at Bus Drop Off and upon arrival at T Bar M Camps & Retreats. These health screenings will include:
 - Symptom Check



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- Brief Questionnaire
 - Temperature Check
 - We encourage you to self-health screen your student at home before coming to drop them off and not to leave the site until your student has been approved by Austin Stone or T Bar M staff.
 - All activities, worship sessions, and meals will be held outdoors.
 - All staff, leaders, and students will be required to wear a mask at all times unless eating or drinking.
 - Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout camp for staff, leaders, and students to practice good hand hygiene often throughout the day.
 - All participants will stay with their DCOMM group and leader during the entirety of the event and limit interaction with other groups. Small groups will sit together, do group activities together, and eat meals together.
 - Activities that would typically allow students to have contact will be limited or items used will be sanitized in between use.

Packing List

Because this is a one-day only event, we ask that your student only brings **ONE** backpack or bag that can fit in their lap. They will have access to cabins and restrooms to store their things, change, and use the restroom. ***Pro-Tip: Label all of your stuff!***

Dress for Success

- Casual clothes for sessions and activities
- Check the weather! We will be outside, so dress accordingly.
- Tennis shoes and/or sandals
- Messy Game: bring a change of clothes for a possible messy game
- Plastic bag/trash bag to put messy clothes in
- Freetime: the pools will be open, so feel free to bring a swimsuit and beach towel.
 - Ladies: Please wear a one-piece modest bathing suit.
 - Guys: No speedos.

- Spending money for SWAG or extra snacks at camp store
- Reusable water bottle



Do Not Pack

- No alcohol, drugs, schoolwork, explosives, or weapons of any kind. These will be taken up and never returned.
